

MOTHER'S DAY HANDPRINT BEE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB24807 Geometrix Large
Square Plate
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
NCR Pattern
Pen

COLORS

CMM 62 – Just Blue CMM 31 – Licorice CMM 91 – Blue Ice CMM 19 – Banana Boat CMM 64 – Sky Blue



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Water down Just Blue paint with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 2. Paint 1-2 coats of the watered-down blue on the front of the plate.
- 3. Once the background is dry, trace on your NCR pattern by pressing firmly with a pen as you trace over all of the lines.
- 4. You can either print the child's hands before painting the bee, or after painting the bee. We used Sky Blue, but any shade of blue will work.
- 5. Fill in the bee with 3 coats of Banana Boat.
- 6. Apply the stripes on the bee with 2 coats of Licorice.
- 7. Water down some Licorice paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Create a messy double outline around your bee and the wings. This is supposed to look whimsical, not perfect.
- 8. Use a detail brush to apply the lettering with one coat of Licorice.
- 9. Add the child's name and the year to either the front or back of the plate.

TIPS

The harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
