CHINOISERIE BUNNY PLATE



MATERIALS

DB37209 Bunny Dish
Liner Brush
Detail Brush
Small Brush
Pencil or Water Based
Marker

COLORS

CMM 47 - Deep Sea
CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon
CMM 43 - Saffire
CMM 64 - Sky Blue

INSTRUCTIONS

1. First, thin down each of the blues by adding 30% water to 70% paint. This will help the paint flow into the lines a little smoother.
2. Use a pencil or a water based marker to gently sketch out nose, whiskers, and eye shape. If using pencil, lightly rub off excess lead from the piece before painting.
3. Fill in the center of the eye and the line for the nose with 2 coats of Deep Sea in the center using a detail brush.
4. Use a liner brush to apply the whiskers and outline of the eye with Blue Lagoon.
5. Next, Use a pencil or a water based marker to gently sketch out flower and leave shapes. If using pencil, lightly rub off excess lead from the piece before painting.
6. Using a small brush, fill in the petals and the leaves using either Sky Blue or Deep Sea. Repeat for a second coat.
7. Use the liner brush to make lines and stems. We alternated between Saffire and Blue Lagoon. We did only one coat on these.

TIPS

- We aren't aiming for perfection, we are looking for that brush mark quality.
